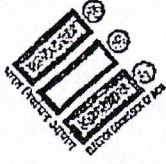

ORDER

"Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party" was registered as a political party under Section 29A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, with effect from 04.05.2017. The Party's registered headquarters address on record with the Election Commission of India is, "Rozy Anima XTTL, Near Akhand Jyoti Hospital, Digha, Patna, BIHAR- 800011"

2. Whereas, the Commission vide its order dated 19.09.2025, had delisted 474 Registered Unrecognised Political Parties (RUPPs), including the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party, on the ground of "failure to contest any election conducted by the Commission for a continuous period of six years since 2019" and;

3. Whereas, representations and appeals were received from such RUPPs against the delisting order and to hear and decide such appeals, a committee has been constituted; and

4. Whereas, the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party had filed representations dated 22.09.2025 & 14.10.2025 before the Commission against the delisting order, wherein the following has been mentioned by the party:

i. The inability to contest elections in the past six years was due to genuine and unavoidable circumstances, including lack of funds and suitable candidates and such circumstances cannot be constructed as voluntary inactivity or abandonment of political activity.

ii. The party applied for symbol with an intension to participate in Bihar Elections 2025; and

5. Whereas, the appeal filed by the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party was heard by the Committee on 29.12.2025 at 11:15 AM through video conference; and

6. Whereas, during the hearing, the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party was represented by Adv. Ashish Fule & Sh. Sunil Kumar Vimal and made submissions of general nature reiterating the points mentioned in its written representation; and

7. Upon due consideration of the submissions made by the party and the report of Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Bihar, the Committee records the following findings:

a. The Commission vide its letter dated 11.08.2025, directed the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) Bihar, to issue show-cause notices to all RUPPs identified for delisting and to afford them an opportunity to appear and submit evidence in support of their case.

b. The CEO, Bihar, duly served the show-cause notice to the Party through the concerned DEO. The notice was also published in the newspaper and also displayed on social media platforms.

c. From the report received from CEO, Bihar, it has been established that the party did not contest any election conducted by the Commission for a continuous period of six years from 2019 to 2025.


8. It is relevant to note here that, Para 3 (xxiii) of the Guidelines for Registration of Political Parties issued by the Commission under Section 29A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 mandates an applicant for registration as a political party to undertake the following:

*"The party must declare in its constitution that it must contest an election conducted by the Election Commission within 5 years of its registration (If the party does not contest elections continuously for 6 years, the Party shall be taken off the list of registered parties)"*

9. The primary objective behind the formation of political parties is to enable political participation and to contest elections. The political parties are governed by the provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, Furnishing of Additional Particulars Order, 1992, the Guidelines for Registration of Political Parties, and the Transparency and Accountability Guideline, 2014 issued by the Commission. All political parties are required to strictly comply with the said statutory provisions, orders and the guidelines as revised and notified by the Commission from time to time.

10. In view of the above, it is ascertained that the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party has not contested any election conducted by the Commission in the last 06 years. Therefore, the present appeal lacks merit and the Bhartiya Yuva Janshakti Party shall remain marked as a delisted RUPP in the register of the RUPPs maintained by the Commission. The appeal is therefore dismissed.
